## LOCAL RULES – JANUARY 2023

### 1. METHODS FOR STOPPING AND RESUMING PLAY – Rule 5

A suspension of play for a Dangerous Situation will be signalled by the Pro Shop as follows:

- One prolonged note of the siren: **Discontinue Play IMMEDIATELY**
- Two short notes of the siren repeated: **Resume Play**

### 2. DROP ZONES – RULE 14

Where complete relief from roads/paths behind the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> holes cannot be obtained, additional relief can be obtained from the nearest Drop Zone, identified by the white painted stones

### 3. ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS – Rule 16

#### (a) Ground Under Repair

The following areas are deemed as ground under repair and relief is available. Where relief is taken it must be in accordance with **Rule 14.3**

- Maintenance entrances to all bunkers
- Bare areas on putting greens
- Where storm damaged trees and branches interfere with a player's ball, stance and/or swing.

#### (b) Immovable Objects

The following are Immovable Objects and relief is available. Where relief is taken it must be in accordance with **Rule 14.3**

- Cross Drains as marked by white stakes
- All Hole plugs on putting greens
- All measuring sign posts and signs on the course
- Penalty stakes
- Water sprinkler system boxes
- All roads and paths on the course even if not artificially surfaced
- Wooden logs defining Garden Borders
- Trees and Shrubs less than two club lengths in height and protected by a tree guard or stake.

#### (c) Garden Beds 18<sup>th</sup> Hole

The Entire Garden Bed from the front of the 18<sup>th</sup> tee continuing along the left hand side of the 18<sup>th</sup> Hole is deemed an Abnormal Ground Condition and relief can be taken in accordance with **Rule 14.3**

**4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN – Rule 16**

Where a ball lies in the General Area and interference exists if an immovable obstruction is:

- (i) On the players line of play, and
- (ii) Is within two club lengths of the putting green, and
- (iii) Is within two club lengths of the ball

The player may take relief under **Rule 16.1b** with the relief to be taken as per **Rule 14**.

**Exception:** There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

**5. OUT OF BOUNDS – Rule 18**

Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side point at ground level of the white stakes and/or boundary fences. The workshop garden bed beyond the 9<sup>th</sup> hole is out of bounds

**6. ROPED OFF AREAS (Bushland Areas)**

All roped areas with Green Stakes and/or ropes, are bushland areas and all buggies and push carts are banned from entering. A ball once found may be played as it lies from the area. Should a ball not be found, it is treated as a lost ball and **Rule 18.2a** applies
