SOME BASIC RULES

When is a Ball Out of Bounds?

A ball is out of bounds when all of it is outside the boundary edge of the course. The boundary edge is defined by the line between the course-side points of the stakes at ground level, and the stakes are out of bounds. *You may stand in the 'Out of Bounds' area to play the ball if it is not 'Out of Bounds'.*

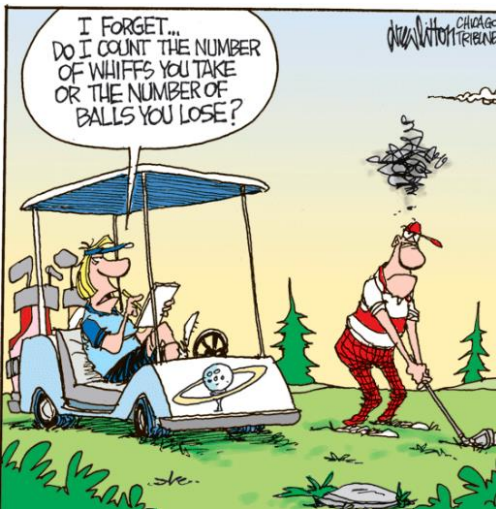
The Flagstick

You may leave the flagstick in the hole, or have it removed (which includes having someone attend the flagstick and remove it after your ball is played). There is normally no penalty if a ball in motion hits the flagstick however if you have the flagstick attended and no reasonable attempt is made to remove the flagstick before the ball is in the hole a general penalty will apply.

Playing a Provisional Ball.

If your ball might be lost outside a penalty area or be out-of-bounds, to save time you may play another ball provisionally under penalty of stroke and distance.

Before the stroke is made, you must announce that you are going to play provisional ball. It is not enough for you to say that you are playing another ball or playing again. You must use the word provisional or otherwise clearly indicate that you are playing the ball provisionally under Rule 18.3
